

## Summer Logistic Internships with Rite of Passage Journeys

Full-time summer logistics internships available on a volunteer basis (at least six weeks of service between May and September; can be up to 10 weeks so will count as WWU internship). These interns greet and orient participants as they arrive at basecamp, organize and pack supplies for the summer backpacking programs, coordinate the food systems, and go out on resupply trips.

Logistics interns are invited to attend Journeys' new staff training in June, a three-day training on mentorship, group facilitation and Journeys' time-tested rite of passage curriculum. Logistics interns are also invited to live at Journeys' basecamp through the duration of their commitment, either camping on the grounds or in our yurt.
