MAINTENANCE CRAFTSMAN, SENIOR – Heyburn State Park, Plummer, ID

The park's towering Ponderosa pines give way to flower-filled meadows and placid waters. Visitors can enjoy the peaceful serenity of cottages, cabins and campsites and admire the work of the Civilian Conservation Corps who built many buildings within the park in the 1930s.
