- Two courses in the period since 1450 CE – one in Europe and one in East Asia, South Asia, Africa or Middle East
- Two courses in Ancient field (prior to 600 CE) – two different continents
- HIST 391 or HIST 392
- One HIST 400-level class & HIST 499
- Electives in History
- Must total 60 credits with at least 30 upper-division credits **AND** minimum of 2.5 GPA (no course with less than C grade)

- ECON 206 or ECON 446
- ECON 207 or 447
- Electives in Social Sciences – Anthropology, Economics, Geography, Political Science, Psychology or Sociology
